Side-Bar: Mark your calendars for NMSU Choir Event at 7pm on April 1 and Game Night at 6:30pm on April 9!

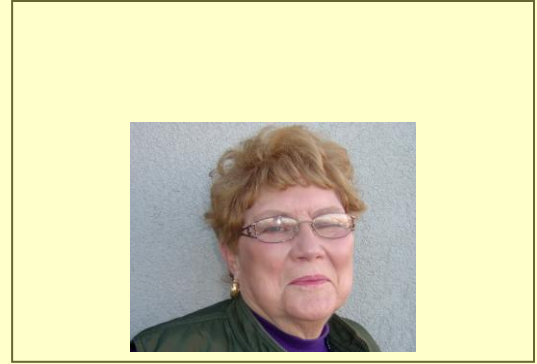
Your Church Family Focus
